**A. Approval to Recommend the Draft 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan incorporating 2025 Entitlement Grants to City Council 4 - 7**

The [draft 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan and draft 2025 Action Plan](#), updated with finalized grant amounts for FY2025, as well as the [draft 2024 Public Participation Plan](#) (Citizen Participation Plan) were released for a second public hearing on June 10. Staff recommends the Social Services Committee (SSC) review and place on file the updated plans; staff further recommends that the Housing and Community Development Committee (HCDC) approve and recommend the draft plans to City Council for approval at the meeting scheduled July 14, 2025. The July 14 City Council meeting will mark the close of the second public comment period for the plans. The consolidated plan and subsequent action plans govern the use of the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) entitlement funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

Funding sources for the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan are the City's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) 2025 entitlement grants; 2024 CDBG and HOME program income; and carryover CDBG and HOME funds from prior years.
