


MINUTES

Mr. Bobkiewicz then mentioned the Harley/Clark Mansion discussion is now a mute issue, because of the advisory opinion of discussing Real Estate Property by the Illinois Attorney General's Office. The only thing that can be discussed in Executive Session will be the amount of money that will be used toward the purchase. So a inform the Council individually through other mechanisms.

The second issue concerns a former employee and Mr. Farrar will take the lead on the matter.

Litigation

Mr. Farrar informed the Council of Ms. Elke-Purze's filing of a lawsuit against the City in Federal Court (5 count complaint). Joe Perkosky is handling the outside case, and while he stated the strategy will be to defeat her allegations. He stated the following facts why he believes she will be buried:

- (1) He has a ton of documents for this two-fold issue
 - (a) Ethical violations
 - (b) Violations of the City Code

He also mentioned the filing of a counter suit and asking for an offset:

- (1) Demanding money from her for City damages
- (2) Sending off resumes
- (3) Using City equipment during work hours
- (4) Emails

Eon Johnston gave an update on the Greenwell case involving the incident with their son's encounter with the Evanston Police. He explained how the family has really been somewhat uncooperative, and how their attorney demanded Mr. Farrar to leave the room while the son was given his deposition.
