A RESOLUTION

Authorizing Permits For Work In the State
Right-of-Way

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston, hereinafter referred to as MUNICIPALITY, located in the County of Cook, State of Illinois, desires to undertake, in the year 1996, the location, construction, operation and maintenance of driveways and street returns, watermains, sanitary and storm sewers, street lights, traffic signals, sidewalks, landscaping, and the like, on State highways, within said MUNICIPALITY, which by law and/or agreement come under the jurisdiction and control of the Department of Transportation of the State of Illinois, hereinafter referred to as DEPARTMENT, and,

WHEREAS, an individual working permit must be obtained from the DEPARTMENT prior to any of the aforesaid installations being constructed either by the MUNICIPALITY or by a private person or firm under contract and supervision of the MUNICIPALITY,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the MUNICIPALITY hereby pledges its good faith and guarantees that all work shall be performed in accordance with the conditions of the permit to be granted by the DEPARTMENT, and to hold the State of Illinois harmless on account of any damages that may occur to persons or property during the prosecution of such work, and assume all liability for damages to

persons due to accidents or otherwise by reason of the work which is to be performed under the provisions of said permit.

SECTION 2: That all authorized officials of the MUNICIPALITY are hereby instructed and authorized to sign said working permit on behalf of the MUNICIPALITY.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
