A Resolution

Authorizing the Interim City Manager to  
Execute An Agreement with the Metropolitan  
Water Reclamation District to Use the  
District Property for Vehicle Extrication  
Training Activities

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston (City) desires to enter a General Permit Agreement with the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRD) to use District Property for Vehicle Extrication Training Activities for the Evanston Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the MWRD agrees to issue a permit and license to the City to use the property located between Main and Oakton Streets on the East Bank of the North Shore Channel in Skokie, Illinois, for the purpose of Vehicle Extraction Training Activities for the Evanston Fire Department,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the Interim City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute an Agreement between the City of Evanston and the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago for the use of property located between Main and Oakton Streets on the East Bank of the North Shore Channel in Skokie, Illinois for the purpose of Vehicle Extrication Training Activities for the Evanston Fire Department. A copy of the proposed Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
