WHEREAS, Resolution 191-8A-89 requires groups of over 100 people desiring
the use the lakefront to obtain City Council approval; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the use of the lakefront pathway system

until 12:45 p.m is hereby approved.


SECTION 2: That said Walk for Hope shall be held in compliance with the Rules
