WHEREAS, his candidacy has the support of the Illinois Municipal League as well as elected officials throughout the country; and


WHEREAS, during all of his work with the National League of Cities, he has brought credit to and deep respect to the City of Evanston; and


SECTION I: That the Evanston City Council urges support of the candidacy of Alderman Gene Feldman for election to the Board of Directors of the National League of Cities.
