AN RESOLUTION

Designating the Mayor the City's Official Representative
to the Northwestern University 1996-1997 Football Bowl Game and
Authorizing Funding

WHEREAS, the Northwestern University Football Team is in the midst of a successful season which may result in a second consecutive national "Bowl" appearance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-6-2 of the Evanston City Code, the Mayor is "recognized as the official head of the City"; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate and in the best interests of the City that the Mayor represent the City at the many public functions and events associated with a "Bowl" game,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor is hereby designated as the official representative of the City to any football "Bowl" game for the 1996-1997 Northwestern University football team.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to allocate and expend monies for the reasonable expenses incurred by the Mayor as Evanston's representative for the aforesaid Bowl game. These expenses shall include but are not limited to, air fare, hotel, meal, ground transportation and football game ticket.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
