

A R E S O L U T I O N

Supporting The United Nations' Presence In Somalia

WHEREAS, the United States, has taken a leadership role with other members of the United Nations, in a humanitarian effort to transport food and medicine to the people in Somalia; and,

WHEREAS, the United States, with other members of the United Nations, has landed in Mogadishu, Somalia, to assure the world that those starving from malnutrition in Somalia will be fed; and,

WHEREAS, the United States, with other members of the United Nations, stand in concert to defend against the looting of food by armed roving gangs, often under the influence of drugs and direction of warlords,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Evanston, Cook County, Illinois:

Section 1. That the City of Evanston and its Human Relations Commission are in total support of the United States and other members of the United Nations, for such a humanitarian effort in their attempt to provide security to relief operations in Somalia.

Section 2. That a copy of this Resolution be sent to the United States Senators from Illinois and the United States Representative from the Ninth Congressional District.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
