

FULLER** was Director of Community Relations and Communications for the American Hospital Association, the former Executive Vice President of the Independent Union of Social Service Employees of Illinois, the past President of the Community and Economic Development Association and served as Democratic Committeeman of Evanston Township from 1974-1982; and


