## A RESOLUTION

Authorizing the City Manager  
to Apply for an Illinois Bicycle Path Grant

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston has adopted a comprehensive plan for  
Lakefront park improvements; and


WHEREAS, that plan includes the implementation of a comprehensive  
Lakefront Bicycle Trail system connecting with the City of Chicago to the  
south and the Green Bay Trail to the north; and

WHEREAS, there is a major portion of said plan that remains  
uncompleted between Greenwood and Dempster Streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston plans to apply for an Illinois  
Bicycle Path Grant from the State of Illinois Department of Conservation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of  
Evanston that the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for an Illinois  
Bicycle Path Grant from the State of Illinois Conservation Department, and  
further that the City Manager be authorized to sign the BP/DOC-5 Certification  
Statement;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Evanston certified that  
it has the financial resource to complete the project prior to receiving the  
grant reimbursement, that it will indemnify and hold harmless the Illinois  
Department of Conservation from any and all liability regarding this project,  
and that the proposed project will be accessible to the public without regard  
to race, color, sex, national origin, age or disability.
