A RESOLUTION

Sister Cities Foundation

WHEREAS, on April 2, 1991, citizens of Evanston passed a referendum to reduce the size of the City Council from eighteen to nine members; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in the size of the City Council will occur effective upon the election of April, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the reduction in the size of the City Council is a fundamental change in the manner in which the City will conduct its business and affairs; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the reduction, it is necessary that the functions and purposes of certain City boards and commissions be consolidated; and

WHEREAS, there are currently four (4) aldermanic members on the Sister Cities Foundation Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON:

SECTION 1: That one Alderman selected by the mayor shall serve on the board of directors of the Sister Cities Foundation.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after May 11, 1993.
