A RESOLUTION

Income Tax Surcharge Resolution
Asking Governor Edgar to Support Municipalities

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has shared with local governments; municipalities and counties, with needed revenues since 1989 with income tax surcharge proceeds;

WHEREAS, the temporary income tax surcharge for municipalities and counties will expire on June 30, 1993;

WHEREAS, municipalities and counties have tremendous financial needs to directly serve the citizens of Illinois with local programs;

WHEREAS, municipalities and counties have expended the revenues in a conservative, productive manner for their citizens;

WHEREAS, the Federal and State government continue to impose unfunded state mandates on local governments;


WHEREAS, this revenue is essential to sound municipal and county fiscal health;

WHEREAS, Governor Edgar will be delivering the State Budget Address on March 3, 1993;


Address the permanent extension of the income tax surcharge with the proceeds dedicated to municipalities and counties.
