A RESOLUTION

Canvassing the Results of the Consolidated Primary Election  
held on February 23, 1993, and Declaring the  
Results of Said Election

WHEREAS, on the Twenty-third day of February, 1993, a Consolidated Primary Election was held in and for the City of Evanston, Cook County, Illinois, for the purpose of determining which two of five mayoral candidates should stand for election at the Consolidated Municipal Election to be held on April 20, 1993.


