

Amending the 1988-89
Community Block Grant Program

WHEREAS, the Evanston City Council with passage of City Resolution 5-R-88 did approve the application for 1988-89 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement funds and did direct the City Manager to file said application with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development approved said application; and

WHEREAS, the Evanston City Council did approve \$97,390 in Community Development Block Grant funds for an Industrial Site Clearance project in the Southwest Industrial area; and

WHEREAS, the project for which Community Development Block Grant funds were allocated (removal of the silos at Marquette Fuel Company) has been accomplished without the use of Community Development funds; and

WHEREAS, the members of the City's Housing and Community Development Act Committee have recommended that the grant funds be utilized for various improvements to the neighborhood to the east and adjacent to the Southwest Industrial area; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act Committee held a public meeting on September 14, 1993 to hear public opinion on the proposed reallocation as required by the Community Development Citizen Participation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's Housing and Community Development Act Committee did vote to approve said reallocation and to recommend to the City Council passage of this Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY ILLINOIS;

Section 1: That the 1988-89 Community Development Block Grant program is amended, authorizing that the \$97,390 previously allocated for removal of the Marquette Fuel Company silos in the Southwest Industrial area be reallocated for various improvements to be made to the neighborhood to the east and adjacent to the Southwest Industrial area; and

Section 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
