A RESOLUTION

Establishing An Energy Policy

WHEREAS, The City of Evanston believes that the conservation of natural resources is important; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 49-O-93 established the Energy Commission as an advisory entity responsible for the coordinated review of electric energy matters; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 23-O-93 established the Environment Board to serve as an environmental advocate for the residents of Evanston; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 49-O-93 has specified that the Energy Commission, Environment Board, and other Boards and Commissions develop a City Energy Policy,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That the City adopt the following Energy Policy:

1. The City shall strive for the goals of reliability, reasonable cost and flexibility in providing for its energy supply.
2. The City shall encourage efficient uses of energy and the conservation of energy, whether that energy be used for lighting, comfort, mobility or the doing of work.


3. The City shall act in the conviction that meaningful reductions in energy use can be accomplished without loss of quality of life or of the economic health of energy users.
4. In all its energy considerations, the City shall consider acting in cooperation with other major nearby users of energy.
5. The City shall seek to influence legislation and regulation at county, state and national levels, as appropriate, in reaching its energy goals.
6. The City government, itself, shall be a leader in energy-related matters, setting goals for efficient and environmentally benign uses of energy in City buildings, vehicles and other energy-using units.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
