A RESOLUTION

Authorizing the City Manager to Enter Into
an Agreement With Evanston Township High School and
Evanston Hospital Corporation
for the Establishment and Operation
of a School-Based Health Clinic

WHEREAS, Evanston Township High School desires to establish a school-based clinic within the school to serve students; and

WHEREAS, Evanston Township High School has applied for and been granted a grant from the Illinois Department of Public Health for the establishment and maintenance of such a clinic; and

WHEREAS, the Evanston City Council on November 21, 1994 voted unanimously to endorse the grant application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston and Evanston Hospital Corporation have agreed to establish a community partnership to create and maintain a school-based health center; and

WHEREAS, a school-based health center would play a very important role in creating a healthy City for Evanston's young people; and

WHEREAS, Evanston Township High School, the City of Evanston and Evanston Hospital Corporation desire to enter into an agreement to create and maintain a school-based health center,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager of the City of Evanston be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to sign, and the City Clerk to attest, the Agreement with Evanston Township High School and Evanston Hospital Corporation, attached as Exhibit 1, which provides for the creation and maintenance of a school-based health center. The City Manager is hereby authorized to negotiate additional terms as he may find necessary and desirable.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
