A RESOLUTION

Authorizing the City Manager to Negotiate Conditions
for Easements with the Metropolitan Water
Reclamation District of Greater Chicago
Phase IV Sewer System Improvements

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston requires two temporary easements and two 25-year easements from the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRDGC) for Phase IV of the Sewer System Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved Resolution 7-R-95 on January 9, 1995 authorizing an Easement Agreement for easements in this Phase IV area of the Sewer System Improvements Plan; and

WHEREAS, it became necessary to modify the limits of the work during the construction of the underground tunneling operations and therefore the limits shown on the Easement Agreement approved by Resolution 7-R-95; and

WHEREAS, a revised Easement Agreement is required by the MWRDGC covering this work area for the Phase IV Sewer System Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, such easements are in the best interest of the City of Evanston.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager of the City of Evanston is hereby authorized to sign the revised easement agreement marked as Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager of the City of Evanston is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate any additional conditions as are in the best interest of the City of Evanston.

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect following its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
