A Resolution

Consenting to Assignment of the
Telecommunication Easement From
Northwestern Technologies Group to Northwestern University

WHEREAS, in December 1986 the City of Evanston, as Grantor, entered into an Easement Agreement with Northwestern University and Northwestern Memorial Hospital acting together as Northwestern Technologies Group, as Grantee, for a Telecommunications System on certain City rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Easement Agreement provides for the installation of telecommunications cable on certain City streets within the City of Evanston rights-of way; and

WHEREAS, the Easement Agreement provides, in paragraph 2d, that the Easement may not be assigned by the Grantee without the written consent of the City of Evanston; and

WHEREAS, Northwestern Memorial Hospital and Northwestern University acting together as Northwestern Technologies Group has utilized and enjoyed the benefits of subject Easement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Northwestern University has notified the City that the Northwestern Memorial Hospital will no longer participate and will withdraw from the Northwestern Technologies Group; and

WHEREAS, Northwestern University has notified the City that Northwestern University will assume all the assets and obligations of Northwestern Technologies Group under the Easement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph 2d of the Easement Agreement Northwestern University has requested the consent of the City of Evanston to the Assignment of the Easement Agreement from the Northwestern Technologies Group to Northwestern University.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Evanston does hereby consent to the Assignment of the Easement for Telecommunication service, entered into July 5, 1984, between the City of Evanston, as the Grantor, and Northwestern University and Northwestern Memorial Hospital acting together as Northwestern Technologies Group as the Grantee, to Northwestern University as the sole Grantee.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
