A RESOLUTION

Declaring a Moratorium  
on the Granting of  
Licenses To Tattoo Facilities

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Evanston has recently passed an ordinance licensing tattoo facilities in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined it is in the best interests of the citizens of Evanston for the Council to further study the regulation, establishment, and location of tattoo facilities in the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has referred the issue of the definition of retail establishment as it relates to tattoo facilities to the Planning and Development Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has referred the issue of medical protection for customers of tattoo facilities to the Human Services Committee; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that no further licenses for tattoo facilities should be granted for six months from the signing of this Resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That no license shall be granted to any tattoo facility in the City of Evanston for six (6) months from the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
