A RESOLUTION

Amending the 1996 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program  
and Authorizing the Reallocation of Unexpended Funds from that  
Program Year to the 1997 CDBG Program

WHEREAS, the Evanston City Council with passage of Resolution 6-R-96 did approve the Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Year 1996/97, which included the City's application for 1996/97 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds; and

WHEREAS, said Consolidated Plan was submitted to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and approved by HUD; and

WHEREAS, unexpended funds are available after completion of the 1996/97 Curb Sidewalk Replacement Program and 1996/97 Alley Resurfacing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act (CD) Committee has determined that it would be desirable to reallocate \$25,000 in unexpended funds from the aforesaid 1996/97 programs to the 1997/98 Curb/Sidewalk Replacement Program; and

WHEREAS, reallocation of said funds would require that the City of Evanston's 1996/97 and 1997/98 Consolidated Plans be amended; and

WHEREAS, the CD Committee did approve said reallocations at its May 13, 1997 meeting, according to CDBG program citizen participation requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Evanston, Cook County, Illinois:


SECTION 1: That the City's Consolidated Plan for Fiscal Year 1996/97 is hereby amended and the following reallocations to the 1997/98 program year are authorized:

**Twenty-second Year (1996/97)**

Curb/Sidewalk Replacement Program	\$22,256
Alley Resurfacing Program	<u>2,744</u>
<b>Total Reallocations to the 1997/98 Curb/Sidewalk Replacement Program</b>	<b>\$25,000</b>

SECTION II: That the City's Consolidated Plans for Fiscal Years 1996/97 and 1997/98 and CDBG program budgets for those years be amended to reflect the aforesaid amendments.

SECTION III: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law
