A RESOLUTION

Approving Use of Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA
for Annual Indian Guide and Princess Campout

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA sponsors the Indian Guide and Princess program in the Evanston area; and

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA has previously held a Lakefront Campout at Evanston's Centennial Park for Indian Guides and Princesses; and

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA desires to use Centennial Park from Saturday, September 27, 1997 at 11am until Sunday, September 28, 1997 at 3 pm for its annual Indian Guides and Princesses Lakefront Campout, for approximately 400 people; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 191-8A-89 requires groups of over 100 people desiring to use the lakefront to obtain City Council approval; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the approval of the use of Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA for its annual Indian Guide and Princess Campout is in the best interest of the City of Evanston,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the use of Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA for its annual Indian Guide and Princess Campout from Saturday, September 27, 1997 at 11 am until Sunday, September 28, 1997 at 3 pm is hereby approved.


