A RESOLUTION

Approving Use of Lakefront Pathway from Centennial Park to Clark Square
for the City of Hope's Walk for Hope

WHEREAS, the City of Hope wishes to hold a fund-raising Walk for Hope to fund cancer research; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hope desires to use lakefront pathway system from Centennial Park to Clark Square Park for a portion of its Walk on October 5, 1997 from 10:00 a.m. until 12:45 p.m., and

WHEREAS, Resolution 191-8A-89 requires groups of over 100 people desiring the use of the lakefront to obtain City Council approval; and


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the use of the lakefront pathway system for this event is an appropriate use of the site;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the use of the lakefront pathway system from Centennial Park to Clark Square Park by the City of Hope's Walk for Hope on October 5, 1997 from 10:00 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. is hereby approved.


Section 2: That said Walk for Hope shall be held in compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Parks/Forestry & Recreation of the City of Evanston.
