A Resolution

Extending the Moratorium on the  
Granting of Licenses to Tattoo Facilities

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Evanston passed Ordinance 39-0-97 licensing tattoo facilities in the City on May 5, 1997; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined it is in the best interests of the citizens of Evanston for the Council to further study the regulation, establishment, and location of tattoo facilities in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Committee of the City Council is continuing to review the zoning regulation of tattoo facilities; and


WHEREAS, the City Council passed Resolution 34-R-97 on May 19, 1997, declaring a moratorium on the granting of licenses to tattoo facilities for six months; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Committee of the City Council has requested that said moratorium be extended for six (6) months from the signing of this Resolution,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That the moratorium on the granting of licenses to tattoo facilities be extended for six (6) months from the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in a manner provided by law.
