A RESOLUTION

Approving Use of Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA for  
Annual Indian Guide and Princess Campout

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA sponsors the Indian Guide and Princess  
program in the Evanston area; and

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA has previously held a Lakefront  
Campout at Evanston's Centennial Park for Indian Guides and Princesses; and

WHEREAS, the McGaw YMCA desires to use Centennial Park from  
Saturday, September 26, 1998 at 11:00 a.m. until Sunday, September 27, 1998 at  
12:00 noon for its annual Indian Guides and Princesses Lakefront Campout, for  
approximately 400 people; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 191-8A-89 requires groups of over 100 people  
desiring to use the lakefront to obtain City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the approval of the use of  
Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA for its annual Indian Guide and Princess  
Campout is in the best interest of the City of Evanston,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:


Section 1: That the use of Centennial Park by the McGaw YMCA for  
its annual Indian Guide and Princess Campout from Saturday, September 26, 1998  
at 11:00 a.m. until Sunday, September 27, 1998 at 12:00 noon is hereby  
approved.

Section 2: That said Lakefront Campout shall be held in compliance  
with the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Parks/Forestry & Recreation of  
the City of Evanston.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from  
and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner required by law.
