A RESOLUTION

A Commitment to Fund the Engineering Portion of the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Grant (CMAQ) for a Traffic Signal Improvement Project on Portions of Ridge Avenue, Church Street, and Davis Street

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston has applied for a grant to fund the improvement and interconnection of 20 traffic signals located on Ridge Avenue, Church Street, and Davis Street under a program called Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ); and

WHEREAS, said project has been designated as project number SI 0201 in the Chicago Area Transportation Study (CATS) and approved by the CATS Policy Committee; and

WHEREAS, this project and has been included as project number 02-99-0006 in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Northeastern Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the program requires that the City of Evanston commit to funding the engineering portion of this project in the amount of \$149,000 (federal share) and \$38,000 (local share); and

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston desires to pursue the funding and implementation of this project, given the stated program requirements,


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City of Evanston has committed funding in the amount of \$187,000 to this project with the understanding that the federal share of \$149,000 will be reimbursed if the City completes the engineering portion of this project in an acceptable fashion.

SECTION 2: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
