A RESOLUTION

Amending the 1993,1994, 1996, 1997, and 1998
Community Development Block Grant Programs
and Authorizing the Reallocation of Unexpended
Funds from those Program Years

WHEREAS, The Evanston City Council with passage of Resolutions 4-R-93, 4-R-94
9-R-96, 31-R-96, 5-R-97, and 4-R-98 did direct the City Manager to file applications for
Community Development Block Grant program activities with the United States Department of
Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid applications were approved by HUD; and

WHEREAS, unexpended funds are available after implementation of certain Community
Development Block Grant program activities; and

WHEREAS, reallocation of said funds requires amendment of the City of Evanston's
previous applications; and

WHEREAS, the City's Housing and Community Development Act Committee did hold
Public Meetings on November 9, 1999 and December 14, 1999 to hear public opinion on
said reallocations according to the Community Development Citizen Participation Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the City Council of the City of Evanston,
Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: That the City's 1993, 1994, 1996, 1997, and 1998 applications for
Community Development Block Grant program activities are hereby amended and the following
reallocations totaling \$231,980 to the 2000-01 Program Year are authorized:
