A RESOLUTION

**Authorizing Community Animal Rescue
Effort ("C.A.R.E.") to Solicit and Obtain Funds
For the Expansion and/or Renovation
Of the Evanston Animal Shelter**

WHEREAS, the Evanston Animal Shelter on Oakton Street plays a significant role in the care, treatment, and adoption of animals within the City of Evanston; and

WHEREAS, the Evanston Animal Shelter is in need of certain renovation, repair, and expansion; and

WHEREAS, Community Animal Rescue Effort (commonly known as, "C.A.R.E.") is a not-for-profit volunteer organization which provides significant and valuable services in the operation of the Animal Control Shelter; and

WHEREAS, C.A.R.E. has been instrumental in developing an extensive animal adoption program at the Animal Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the success of the animal adoption program has resulted in the need for additional space for the care and custody of animals.

WHEREAS, C.A.R.E. is desirous and willing to assist and participate in the renovation, expansion, and repair of the Evanston Animal Shelter; and

WHEREAS, C.A.R.E. will solicit funds for the renovation, repair, and expansion of the Animal Control Shelter; and

WHEREAS, all funds obtained by C.A.R.E. in its solicitation for the Evanston Animal Shelter will be utilized in the renovation, repair, and expansion of the Animal Control Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the assistance of C.A.R.E. in soliciting funds for the renovation, repair, and expansion of the Animal Control Shelter is in the best interests of all of the citizens of the City of Evanston, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That C.A.R.E. is authorized and designated as a fundraising organization to solicit and obtain funds for the renovation, repair, and expansion of the Evanston Animal Shelter; and

SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
