A RESOLUTION

**Amending the Fiscal Year 2001/02 and 2002/03
Community Development Block Grant Programs and
Authorizing the Reallocation of Unexpended Funds**

WHEREAS, the City Council, with the passage of 02-R-01 and 01-R-02 did approve the City's applications ("Annual Action Plans") for Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") and HOME Investment Partnership ("HOME") and Emergency Shelter Grants ("ESG") entitlement funds for Fiscal Year 2001/02 and Fiscal Year 2002/03, and did direct the City Manager to file said applications with the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD"); and

WHEREAS, said applications for Fiscal Year 2001/02 and Fiscal Year 2002/03 funds were submitted and approved by HUD; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are needed to complete the Fiscal Year 2002/03 Rear Building Renovation project at the Child Care Center of Evanston, located at 1840 Asbury in Evanston; and

WHEREAS, there are unexpended CDBG funds in the Fiscal Year 2001/02 CDBG Administration budget, which can be used to supplement the needed additional funds for the Rear Building Renovation project; and

WHEREAS, reallocation of said funds would require that the City's 2001/02 and 2002/03 CDBG program budgets and the City's Annual Action Plans for Fiscal Year 2001/02 and Fiscal Year 2002/03 be amended; and

WHEREAS, the Housing & Community Development Act Committee did hold a public meeting on September 17, 2002 to hear public opinion on the proposed reallocation request, according the CDBG program Citizen Participation Plan, and said Committee approved said reallocation;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That the City's Fiscal Year 2001/02 and Fiscal Year 2002/03 CDBG programs are hereby amended and the following reallocation to the 2002/03 CDBG program are authorized:

FROM: 2001/02 CDBG Administration	\$7,342
TO: 2002/03 Child Care Center Rear Building Renovation	\$7,342

SECTION 2: That the City of Evanston's Annual Action Plans for Fiscal Year 2001/02 and Fiscal Year 2002/03 programs are hereby amended to reflect the aforesaid reallocation.

SECTION 3: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
