**A RESOLUTION**

**Designating the Portions of Davis Street,  
Sherman Avenue and Orrington Avenue  
Abutting Fountain Square With the Honorary Name,  
"Fountain Square Veterans Memorial Plaza"**

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 39-R-96 established an Honorary Street Name Sign Program to honor certain individuals who have contributed greatly to the City of Evanston through cultural, historic, or humanitarian acts; and

**WHEREAS**, Evanston's 351 Gold Star Veterans gave their lives in the Civil War, the Spanish-American War, World War I, World War II, The Korean Conflict and the Vietnam Conflict; and

**WHEREAS**, the sacrifice of the lives of these 351 Evanston Veterans to preserve all that this nation stands for, exemplifies their concern to improve the welfare and happiness of all residents of Evanston; and

**WHEREAS**, many of the veterans were graduates of Evanston Schools and have relatives and friends that currently reside in Evanston,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

**SECTION 1:** That appreciation is hereby expressed to the 351 Gold Star Veterans for service to the City of Evanston by designating with the honorary name, "Fountain Square Veterans Memorial Plaza" those portions of Davis Street, Sherman Avenue and Orrington Avenue abutting Fountain Square.

**SECTION 2:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
