A RESOLUTION

**Supporting Application for
Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) Funds
to Improve Certain Streets in the City of Evanston**

WHEREAS, the Surface Transportation Program (STP) is a program of the United States Department of Transportation that allocates federal transportation funding to local agencies for rehabilitation of certain eligible routes; and

WHEREAS, Emerson Street, Asbury Avenue, Main Street, Dodge Avenue and Church Street are all STP-eligible roadways in the City; and

WHEREAS, certain sections of Emerson Street, Asbury Avenue, Main Street, Dodge Avenue and Church Street are in deteriorating condition; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to improve these roadways; and

WHEREAS, City staff has estimated the total cost of roadway resurfacing for certain deteriorated sections of these streets to be as follows:

1. Emerson Street – Leland Avenue to Green Bay Road (\$423,564.00)
2. Dodge Avenue – Howard Street to Church Street (\$896,000.00)
3. Dodge Avenue – Church Street to Emerson Street and Church Street – Dodge Avenue to Ridge Avenue (\$349,576.00)
4. Asbury Avenue – Main Street to Dempster Street and Main Street – Asbury Avenue to Sheridan Road (\$671,660.00); and


WHEREAS, the STP funding program requires a 30% local match under program requirements;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE EVANSTON CITY COUNCIL OF COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:


SECTION 1: That the City supports the application for Surface Transportation Program funding for the roadway improvements described herein.

SECTION 2: That the City will fund the required thirty percent (30%) local share requirements for these projects from either the Motor Fuel Tax or the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).

SECTION 3: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption in the manner provided by law.
