A RESOLUTION

**Authorizing Applications for and Execution of a
Technical Assistance Grant for a
Skokie Swift North Shore Corridor Market Analysis under the Regional
Transportation Authority's General Authority
to Make such Grants**

WHEREAS, the Regional Transportation Authority (the "Authority"), is authorized to study public transportation problems and developments; and to conduct, in cooperation with other public and private agencies, such studies; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the power to expend funds for use in connection with these studies; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has the power to make and execute all contracts and other instruments necessary or convenient to the exercise of its powers; and

WHEREAS, approval for said funds will require the City of Evanston to commit \$15,000 in local matching funds;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:**

SECTION 1: That the foregoing recitals are hereby found as fact and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: That the Evanston City Manager is authorized to execute and file applications on behalf of the City of Evanston with the Regional Transportation Authority for a technical assistance grant for the Skokie Swift North Shore Corridor Market Analysis.

SECTION 3: That the Evanston City Manager is authorized to furnish such additional information, assurances, certifications and amendments as the Regional Transportation Authority may require in connection with this technical assistance grant application.

SECTION 4: That the Evanston City Manager is authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Evanston to execute and deliver grant agreements and all subsequent amendments thereto between the City of Evanston and the Regional Transportation Authority for technical assistance grants, and the City Clerk is authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Evanston to attest said agreements and all subsequent amendments thereto.

SECTION 5: That the City Manager is authorized and directed to take such action as is necessary or appropriate to implement, administer and enforce said agreements and all subsequent amendments thereto on behalf of the City of Evanston.

SECTION 6: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
