WHEREAS, Rev. Curry founded the Evanston Youth Initiative Community Organization in 2005, touching the lives of thousands of children and their families throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Curry is the founding President of Food Aide Center of Evanston, assisting 1,200 to 1,500 City families each month; and

WHEREAS, Rev. Curry served as President of the Evanston Ministerial Alliance from 1992 to 1999; and


WHEREAS, Rev. Curry's extraordinary and heartfelt contribution to the citizens of the City of Evanston should be commemorated,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL

SECTION 1: That, on behalf of all citizens of the City of Evanston, appreciation is hereby expressed for Rev. Curry's service to the City and, in particular, to the children of the City by designating that portion of Simpson
