A RESOLUTION

Designating that Portion of Forest Avenue between Kedzie Street and Keeney Street with the Honorary Street Name Sign, "Lauterbach Way"

WHEREAS, beginning in 1975, Ned Lauterbach served as Third Ward Alderman until 1985; and

WHEREAS, Alderman Lauterbach served on the Human Services Committee for eight years considering issues involving public health, mental health, aging, emergency assistance, and purchased human services, and Chaired the Evanston Commission on Aging from 1979 to 1983 advocating on behalf of older Evanstonians; and

WHEREAS, in 1990, having previously served as Chairman of Evanston's Flood and Pollution Control Commission as an Alderman, Mr. Lauterbach returned to the Commission as a citizen member. He was instrumental in guiding the Commission through a difficult period addressing potentially disastrous health issues arising from the City sewer system's inadequacy to handle rain runoff; and

WHEREAS, in response to the proposed demolition of the former Noyes Elementary School, Mr. Lauterbach joined a galvanized community effort organizing a matching fundraising campaign dedicated to refurbishing the 1892 structure. He vigorously spoke out in favor of creating the present vibrant Noyes Cultural Arts Center which provides cultural resources for all Evanstonians; and

WHEREAS, Albe and Ned Lauterbach have shown their love of Evanston by living in "their" Forest Avenue block for more than 48 years and then, in retirement,

looking no further than downtown Evanston while having every opportunity to move elsewhere; and




