A RESOLUTION

Establishing That All ILCC Review or Appeal of All Orders or Actions Taken by the Local Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of Evanston Shall Be Made on the Official Record Made Before the Commissioner

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston, Illinois, is a Home Rule municipal corporation of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, The Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/7-9, provides in pertinent part that:


Any appeal to the Illinois Liquor Control Commission ("ILCC") shall be limited to a review of the official record of the proceedings of such local liquor control commissioner if the city council or board of trustees or county board, as the case may be, has adopted a resolution requiring that such review be on the record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: That effective upon the passage of this resolution, all review or appeal of the actions or orders of the Local Liquor Control Commissioner of the City of Evanston, Illinois, shall be made by the Illinois Liquor Control Commission on the official record made before the Local Liquor Control Commissioner. All resolutions or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2: That this Resolution 27-R-11 shall be in full force and

effect from and after the date of its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
