**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:**


**SECTION 1:** The foregoing recitals are hereby found as fact and incorporated herein by reference.
