A RESOLUTION

Amending the 2016 Community Development Block Grant Program and Authorizing the Reallocation of Unexpended Funds

WHEREAS, in a review of projects funded by Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) programs in prior years, the City has identified eighty-two thousand, seven hundred forty-four dollars (\$82,744.00) in unexpended funds from completed or cancelled projects for reallocation to other eligible CDBG activities in order to address needs in the year ahead, and to maintain timely use of funds per U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) guidelines; and

WHEREAS, HUD approved the FY 2008, 2012, 2013 and 2014 CDBG program activities as set forth in the City’s application to HUD, filed by the City Manager at the direction of the Evanston City Council, and reallocation of said funds requires amendment of the City’s FY 2008, 2012, 2013 and 2014 CDBG application; and

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston did publish the thirty (30)-day comment period from October 19, 2015, through November 17, 2015, and the City’s Housing and Community Development Act Committee did hold a public meeting on November 17, 2015, to hear public opinion on said proposed reallocations according to the Citizen Participation Plan in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby found as fact and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2: The City's FY 2008, 2012, 2013 and 2014 application for Community Development Block Grant program activities is hereby amended, and eighty-two thousand, seven hundred forty-four dollars (\$82,744.00) is approved for reallocation to the City's 2016 CDBG program as follows:
