A RESOLUTION

Amending the 2016 and 2017 Community Development Block Grant Programs and Authorizing the Reallocation of Unexpended Funds

WHEREAS, in a review of projects funded by Community Development Block Grant (“CDBG”) programs in prior years, the City has identified twenty-four thousand, nine hundred forty seven dollars (\$24,947) in unexpended funds from completed or cancelled projects for reallocation to other eligible CDBG activities in order to address needs in the year ahead, and to maintain timely use of funds per U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (“HUD”) guidelines; and

WHEREAS, HUD approved the FY 2016, and 2017 CDBG program activities as set forth in the City’s applications to HUD, filed by the City Manager at the direction of the Evanston City Council, and reallocation of said funds requires amendment of the City’s FY , 2016 and 2017 CDBG applications; and

WHEREAS, the City of Evanston did publish the thirty (30)-day comment period from October 15, 2018, through November 13, 2018, and the City’s Housing and Community Development Act Committee did hold a public meeting on November 13, 2018, to hear public opinion on said proposed reallocations according to the Citizen Participation Plan in the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVANSTON, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:


SECTION 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby found as fact and

SECTION 2: The City's FY 2016 and 2017 applications for Community Development Block Grant program activities is hereby amended, twenty-four thousand, nine hundred forty-seven dollars (\$24,947) is approved for reallocation to the City's 2019 CDBG program as follows:
