6. EXECUTIVE SESSION

A. Motion to Convene Into Executive Session

Pursuant to 5 Illinois Compiled Statutes ("ILCS") 120/2a, I move that the Citizen Police Review Commission convene into Executive Session to discuss agenda items regarding personnel. The exception is 5 ILCS 120/2(a), (c)(1) as set forth as follows: §2. (c) Exceptions. A public body may hold closed meetings to consider the following subjects: (1) The appointment, employment, compensation, discipline, performance, or dismissal of specific employees of the public body or legal counsel for the public body, including hearing testimony on a complaint lodged against an employee of the public body or against legal counsel for the public body to determine its validity.
