I have some issues with the style and execution of this home:
1. The architectural style is unlike anything in our historic neighborhood. It looks more like a modern barn than a historical home
2. The materials of the home are not up to the style of our neighborhood: the roof is tin and the siding is composite -- there are no other home for blocks with this combination of elements
